

MIND WARS, AND PEACE OF MIND

In our modern era of social media and smart communication, war is first and foremost fought over our minds. War begins in the news and by means of controlling the narrative of who and what is right or wrong. Only a handful of corporations own 90% of all news outlets and TV stations who present the desired narrative, and social media networks like Facebook and Twitter use algorithms and thousands of content monitoring employees to filter posts and tailor adverts. Based on profiling techniques and market behaviour analysis social networks and e-commerce platforms such as Amazon are able to predict as well as guide your next purchase.

Recently Facebook co-founder Sean Parker admitted that the system is consciously and intentionally built to make its user addicted based on an advanced understanding of the mechanism of the human brain.

Research from as early as 1972 shows that human thinking as "sub-vocal speech" can be both read and influenced *remotely* by the appropriate electromagnetic wave patterns and radio-frequency pulses. It is since then possible to look into a person's brain and decode intentions, before the person acts them out. Furthermore, similar technologies are able to influence a person's propensity towards speaking the truth or falsehood putting into question whether our thoughts and statements really are still our own.

Using pulsed ultra-sonic signals aimed at specific areas of the brain it is now possible to beam sensory perceptions such as sounds, images and even smells into the brain blurring the line between real-world perception and electromagnetically or acoustically induced perception.

Trance-like or hypnotic states can be induced by the flicker and frequency rates of TV and computer screens or by certain sound frequencies that correspond with the intrinsic frequency of biological signals or by pulsed electromagnetic fields even if not looking at the screen (through the skin).

A person under hypnosis will no longer use the rational filter of neo-cortex activity to assess the veracity of information thus accepting information that they may not take seriously with their normal brain functions active.

Technologies of persuasion are not only used in the silent and domestic attack on our minds for economic, political or social purposes but also in active warfare situations such as was demonstrated by so-called "Voice of God" technologies applied in the Iraq war. And it is known historically that hypnosis was used by child assassins in the ancient Persian Empire.

As long as an understanding of these technologies is not common knowledge among society at large war will continue to sell and will continue to be profitable.

The human mind, however, is not a victim but is equipped with its own neurological and quantum physical 'technologies' of creativity and liberation. It may be argued that the true reason for the end of the Cold War was the development of 'Remote Viewing' that both sides of the Iron Curtain entertained indicating that the abilities of the mind can neutralise the threat of nuclear weapons.

Experiments in the so-called Kozyrev Mirror have demonstrated the interconnection and interaction of human consciousness and the properties of space and time, and the interscalar perspective of Global Scaling is pointing out that the functional frequencies of the human (and mammalian) brain is directly linked to much larger processes of the order of the solar system and the galaxy.

Finally, with the findings of the Blue Brain Project we are on the verge of accessing the hyper-dimensional resonance of the cerebral networks. This is not just abstract knowledge. Rather, when people begin to access this innate ability of human consciousness to link across space and time we may finally begin to discover a Peace that surpasses our current human understanding.
